## What is Domestic Violence

Willful intimidation, physical assault, battery, sexual assault, threats, and/or emotional and psychological abuse used to exert control over another person within the home. How often this occurs in the home varies in both frequency and severity. Domestic Violence affects all people regardless of age, race, religion, nationality, gender, sexual orientation, or socio-economic status. Domestic violence can cause psychological trauma, physical harm, and possibly death.

## SAFE House Provides:

Victims of domestic violence and their dependent children receive safe and confidential services at NO COST at SAFE House. Services include:

- Emergency shelter
- Safety planning
- Court advocacy
- Therapy
- 24-hour hot-line
- Transitional housing
- Follow-up services
- Community outreach
